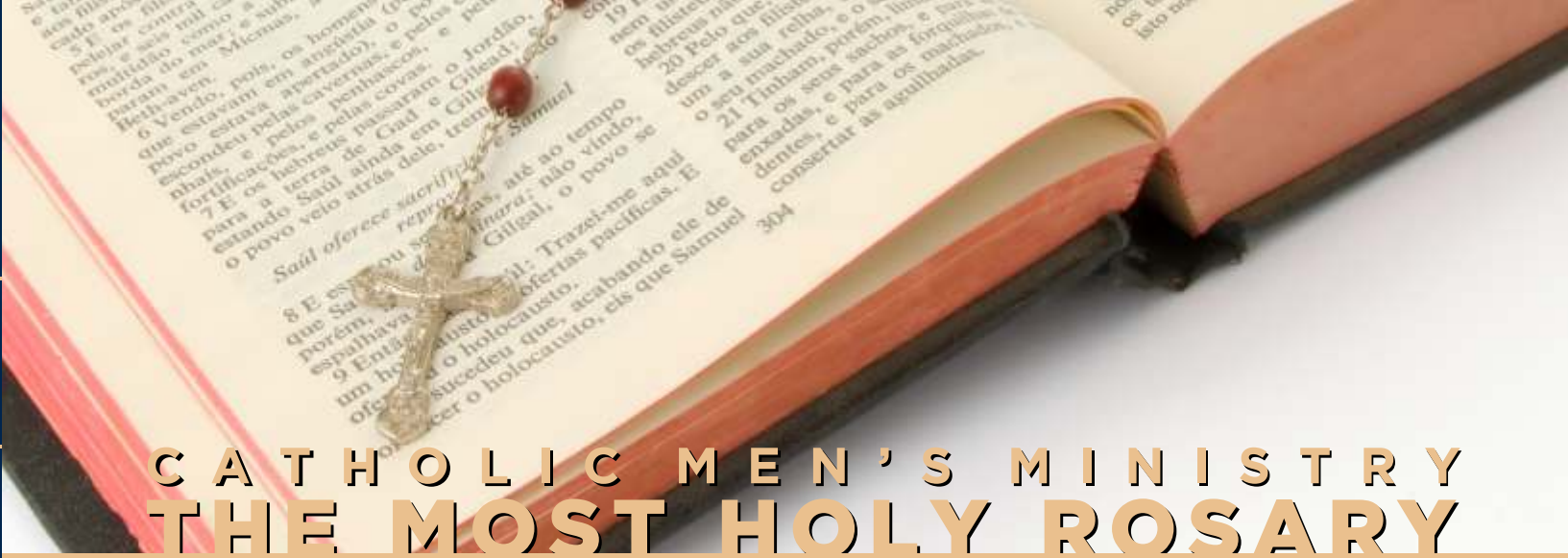

CONTEMPLATION STARTER

Brothers, before we pray, let us first contemplate the rosary from three perspectives:

- 1 First, it serves as a school of sanctity, aiding us in our mission to become holy. In this most powerful of schools we are taught by Mary herself and through our faithful and regular recitation of it we grow in virtue, coming to resemble more and more the One whose life we reflect upon in each mystery - Jesus.

Do we wish to become saints dear brothers? Then let us pray daily the rosary!

- 2 Second, the rosary serves as a great spiritual weapon, fashioned by the Divine Craftsman Himself to help us in our battle against the principalities and powers of darkness. Consider that it includes from sacred scripture both the Our Father and the Hail Mary - making the decades of the rosary a spiritual machine gun. Every bead prayed becomes a carefully aimed bullet - an explosion of faith that frightens Satan and his evil spirits. For as we pray the rosary we pray God's Word, the Sword of the Spirit - becoming even stronger Soldiers of Christ and Knights of Mary, and helping them once again crush his head.

Oh brothers, to pray the rosary is to enter onto the battlefield for souls and to participate in our Lord's great victory!

- 3 And third, the rosary is commended to us by many of our Church's greatest saints and popes, including those of contemporary times. Here are quotes of three recent popes:

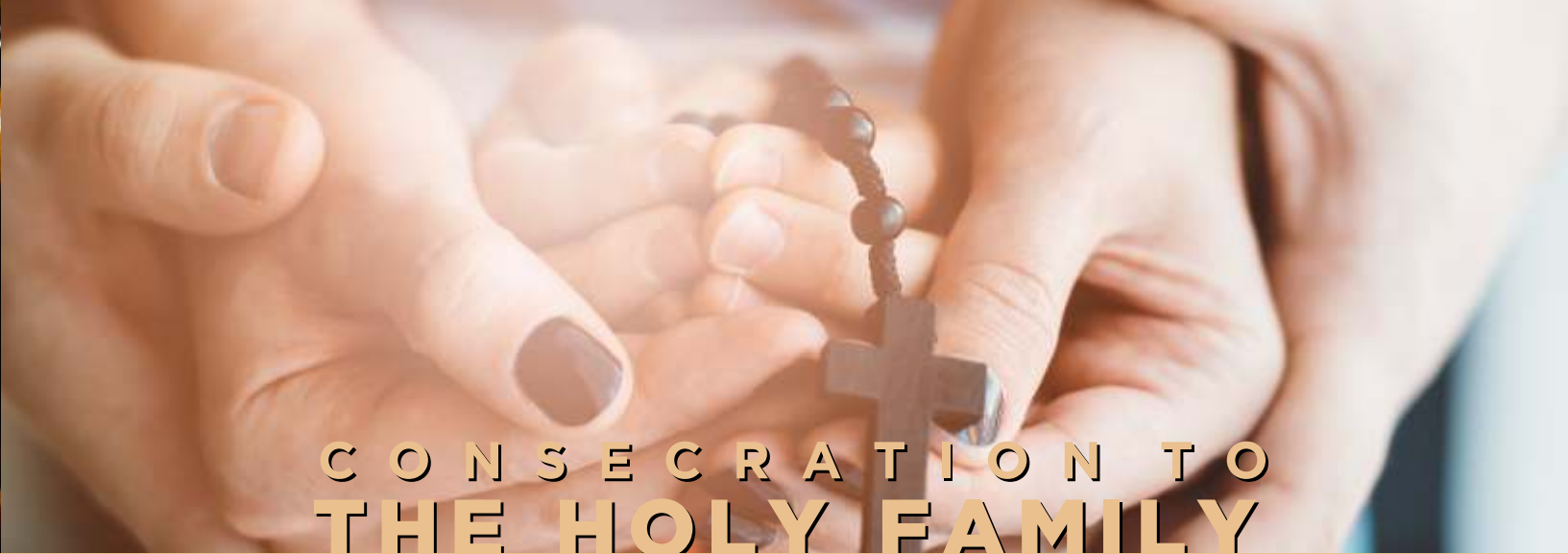

We entrust our family to you.

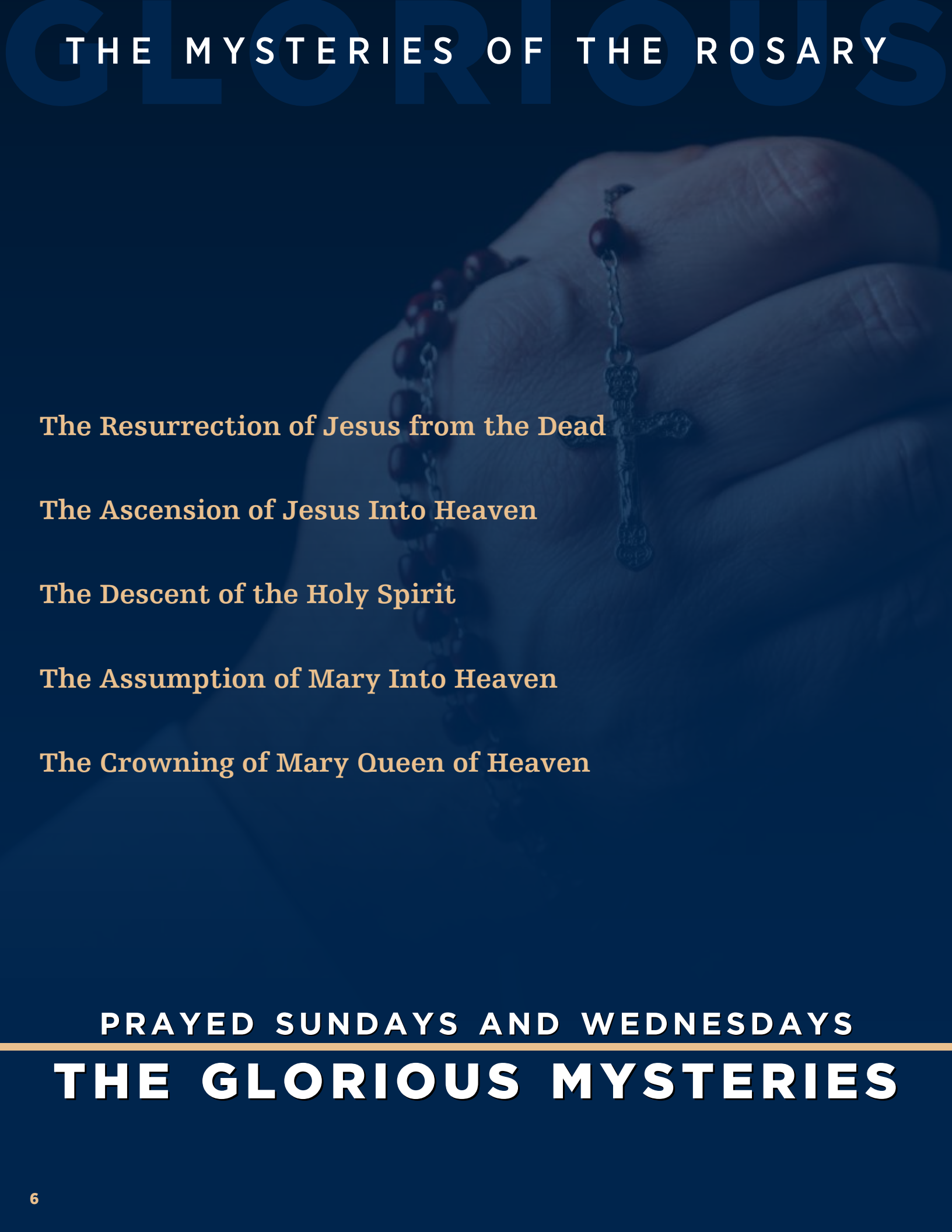
O Saint Joseph, you provided a secure and loving home for Jesus and Mary, and gave us a model of fatherhood while showing us the dignity of work.

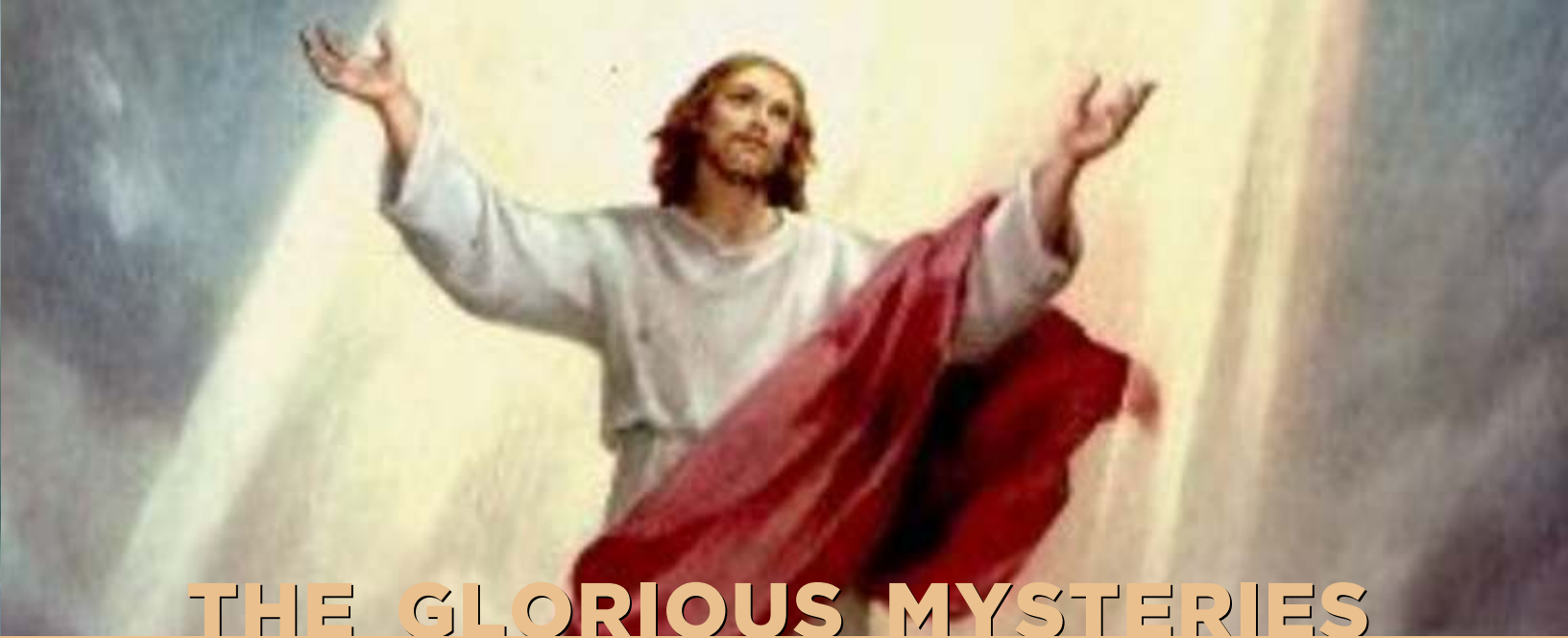
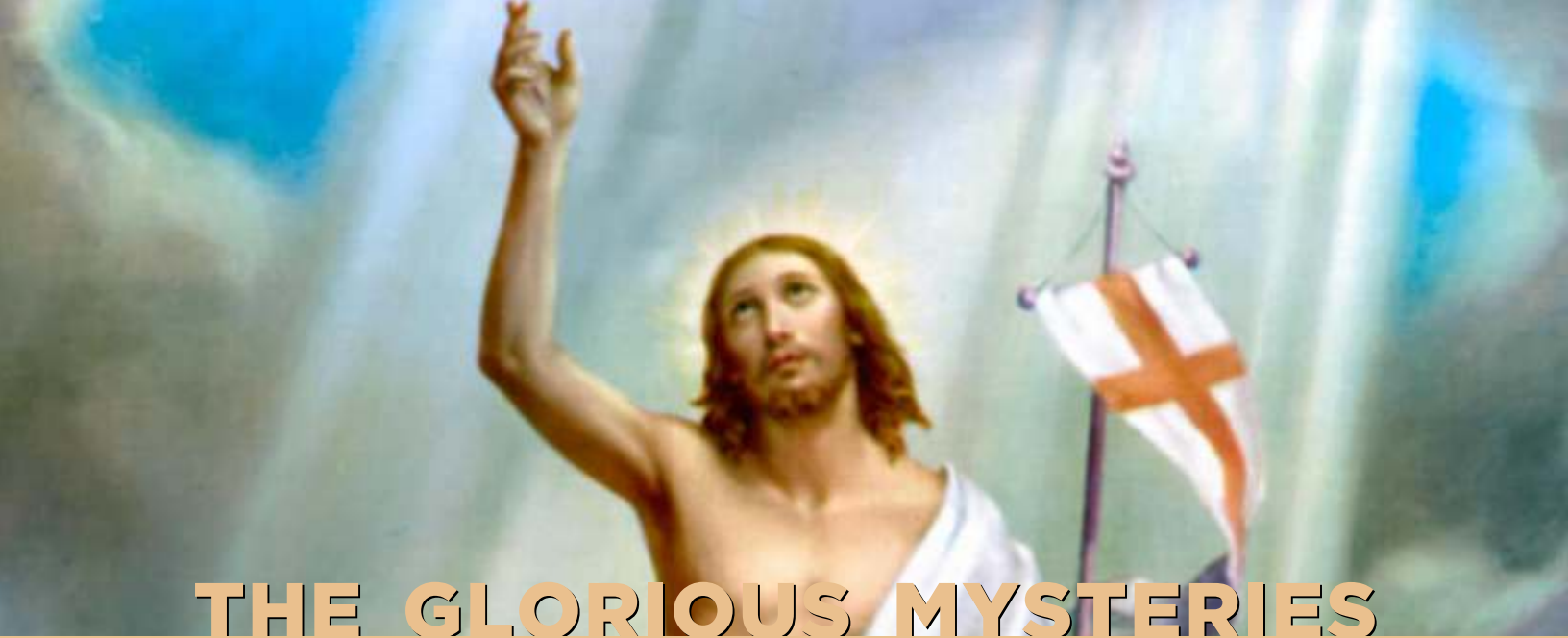

Third Glorious Mystery: The Descent of the Holy Spirit

Mary is present with the women when the Holy Spirit comes upon the Apostles like tongues of fire. An ancient antiphon in the prayer of the church describes what happened, this is the day of Pentecost, allelujah. Today the Holy Spirit appeared to the disciples in the form of fire and gave them His special gifts. He sent them into the world to proclaim that whoever believes and is baptised will be saved. Fourth Glorious Mystery: Mary is Taken Up Into Heaven

Fifth Glorious Mystery: The Coronation of Mary in Heaven

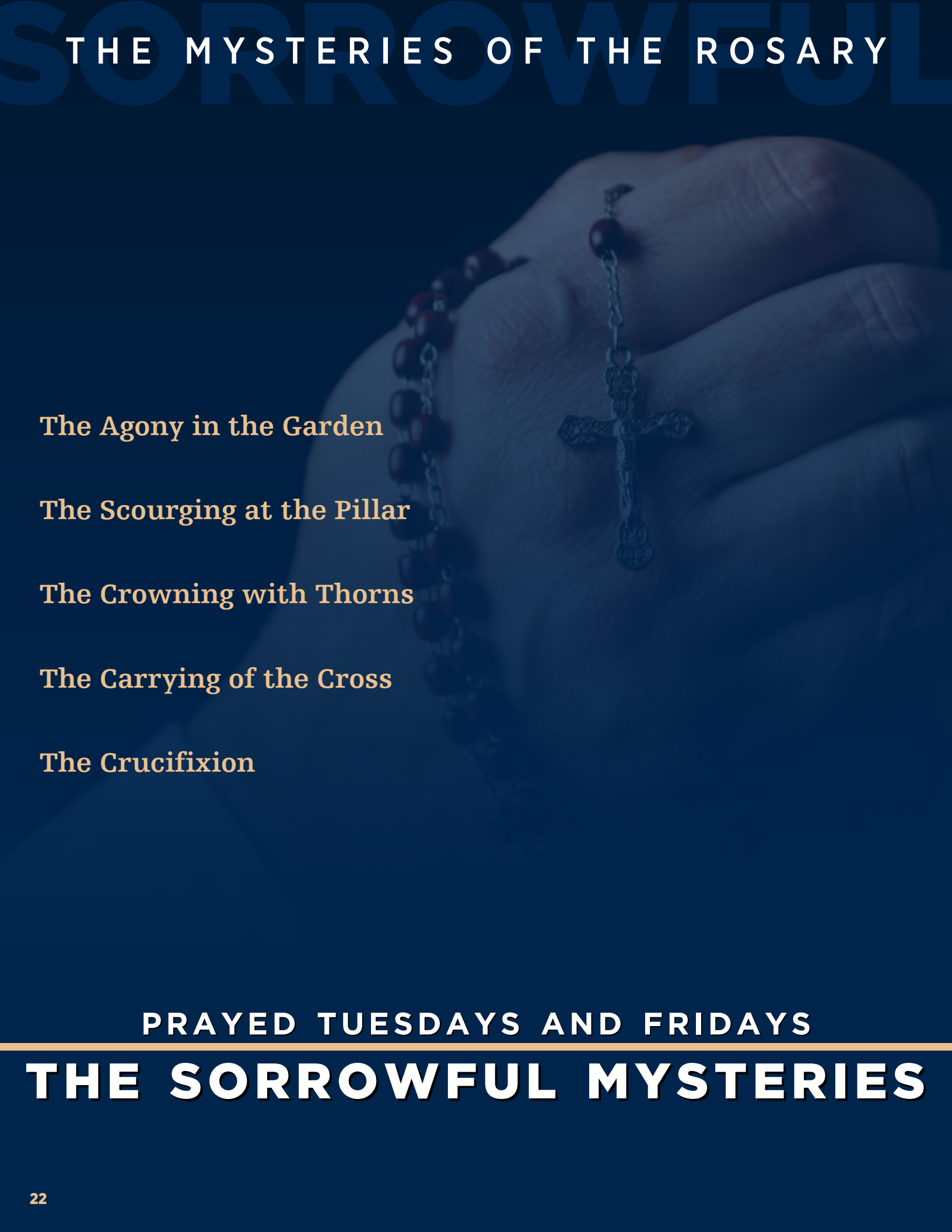

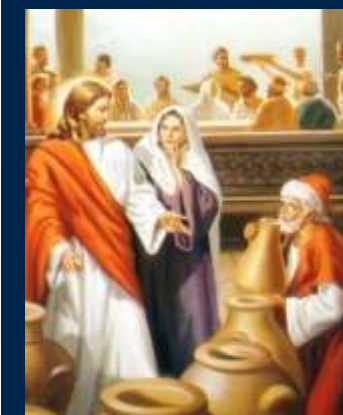

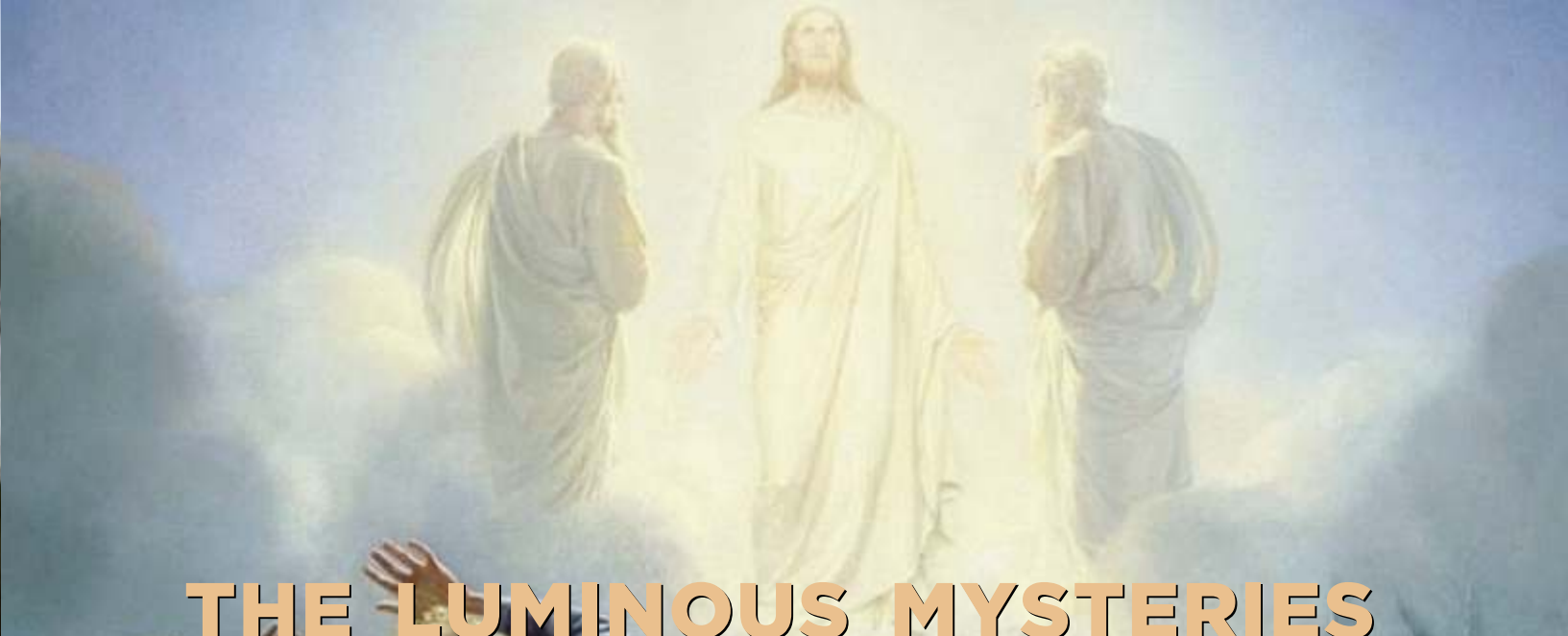

Fourth Luminous Mystery: The Transfiguration

ABOUT THE MYSTERIES AND FRUITS OF THE ROSARY

The Mysteries of the Rosary are meditations on episodes in the life and death of Jesus from the Annunciation to the Ascension and beyond. These are traditionally grouped by fives into themed sets known as the **Joyful (or Joyous) Mysteries**, the **Sorrowful Mysteries**, the **Glorious Mysteries** and the **Luminous Mysteries**.

Typically, a spiritual goal known as a "fruit" is also assigned to each mystery of the Most Holy Rosary. The Fruit of the Glorious, Joyful, and Sorrowful Mysteries we've used are listed from the appendix of Louis Marie de Montfort's book *Secret of the Rosary*. The Luminous Mysteries were instituted by Pope John Paul II, in his apostolic letter *Rosarium Virginis Mariae* (October 2002).
