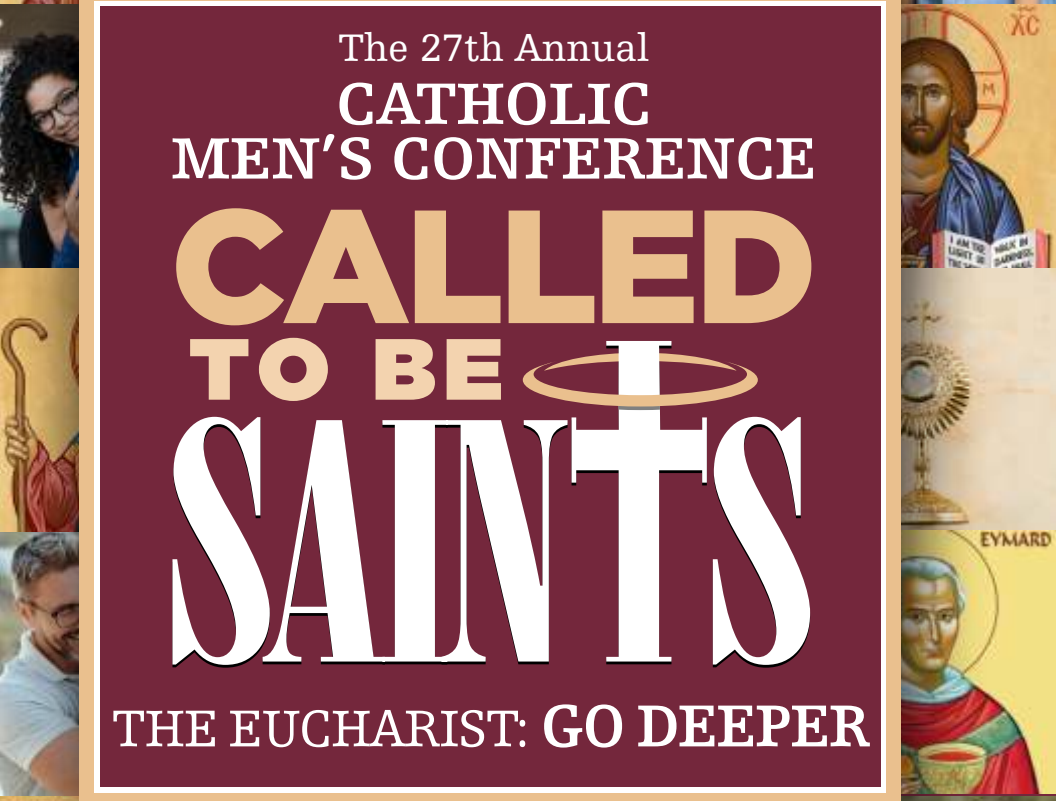

To the Participants of the Catholic Men's Conference:

I am delighted to welcome you to the annual Catholic Men's Conference. I pray that this day will be one filled with grace that fosters spiritual growth of everyone participating in this event and strengthens men to be leaders of faith in their families and in the public square.

The theme of your conference, "The Eucharist: Go Deeper" is particularly relevant during this Eucharistic Revival Year as we approach the National Eucharistic Congress in July in Indianapolis. The Second Vatican Council speaks of the Eucharist as the "source and summit" of all life in the Church.

In his exhortation *Sacramentum caritatis*(n. 71), Pope Benedict XVI wrote:

"Christianity's new worship includes and transfigures every aspect of life: ... Christians, in all their actions, are called to offer true worship to God. Here the intrinsically eucharistic nature of Christian life begins to take shape. The Eucharist, since it embraces the concrete, everyday existence of the believer, makes possible, day by day, the progressive transfiguration of all those called by grace to reflect the image of the Son of God (cf. *Rom* 8:29ff.). There is nothing authentically human – our thoughts and affections, our words and deeds – that does not find in the sacrament of the Eucharist the form it needs to be lived to the full. Here we can see the full human import of the radical newness brought by Christ in the Eucharist: the worship of God in our lives cannot be relegated to something private and individual, but tends by its nature to permeate every aspect of our existence."

It is my sincere hope that all those gathered for the Men's Conference will enter more deeply into the Mystery of the Eucharist and transform our culture and society into a Eucharistic one.

Most Reverend Earl K. Fernandes was ordained and installed as the 13th Bishop of the Diocese of Columbus on May 31, 2022. He was serving as pastor of St. Ignatius of Loyola Church in Cincinnati, Ohio from 2019 until his ordination and installation. From 2016-2019, he was a member of the Staff of the Apostolic Nunciature in Washington, D.C. From 2008-2016, he was the Dean of the Athenaeum of Ohio/Mount Saint Mary's Seminary of the West in Cincinnati and an associate professor of moral theology. He holds a doctorate in moral theology from the Alphonsian Academy in Rome.

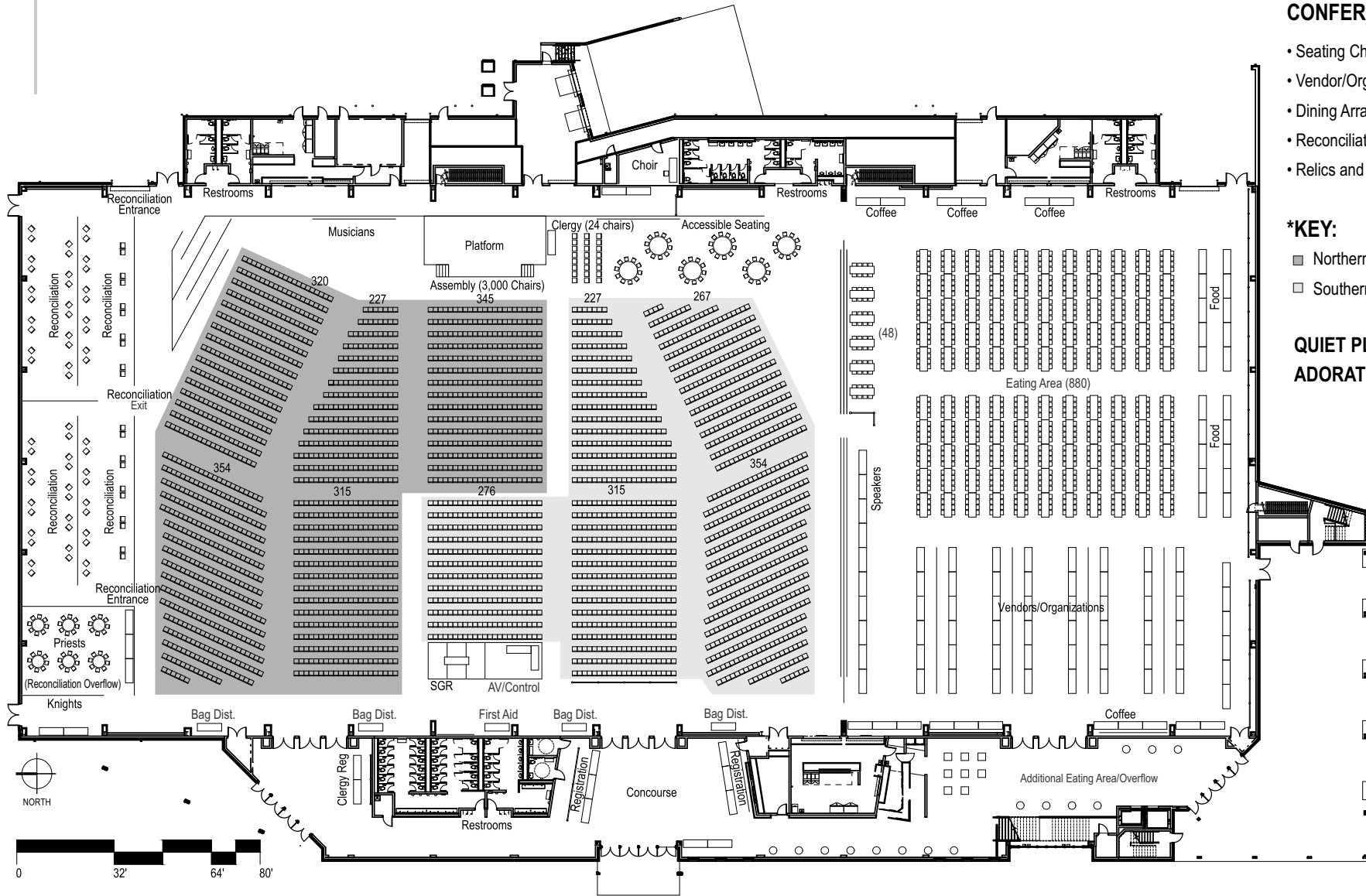


### MIKE TENNYSON

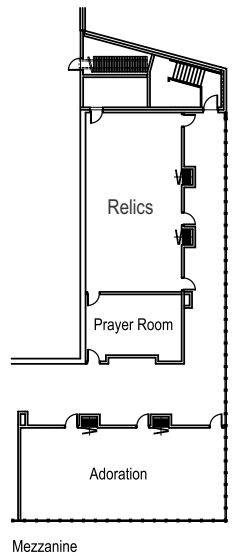
**CONFERENCE FLOORPLAN**

Brad is a galvanizer. His authentic, passionate, and uplifting leadership style brings people together and provides common purpose, and his strategic, yet practical, mindset has quickly established him as a thought leader on mission and evangelization within the Church.

He serves as the Missionary Program Director at Damascus – a Catholic missionary movement that helps as many people as possible encounter

Jesus through camps, retreats, and events. In addition to overseeing the young adult missionaries at Damascus, Brad speaks to thousands every year and is the co-host of Beyond Damascus, a national Catholic radio show and podcast.

**FATHER BURKE MASTERS**

Father Burke Masters is known as “The Baseball Priest,” serving as the chaplain for the Chicago Cubs since 2013 – including being part of their World Series Championship in 2016.

Fr. Burke was born and raised in Joliet. He attended Providence Catholic High School, where he converted to Catholicism in 1985. He studied mathematics and played

baseball at Mississippi State University, playing in the College World Series in 1990. He worked as an actuary for Kemper Insurance and as the ticket manager for the Kane County Cougars before entering Mundelein Seminary in 1997. He has been a priest since June 1, 2002, and spent his first four years at St. Mary's in West Chicago.

From 2006 to 2018 he served as the Vocation Director for the Diocese of Joliet. In 2018, he became the Director of the Office of Adult Formation for the Diocese of Joliet. He started the Catholic Sports Camps in the Diocese of Joliet because of his passion to combine faith and sports, and he works closely with the John Paul II Healing Center and Dr. Bob Schuchts, giving retreats and conferences on healing.

## RELICS OF PADRE PIO

The **National Centre for Padre Pio**, located in Barto, PA, has made our conference one of the stops on their **#SaintPioRelicTour2024**, and will present a relic glove by Padre Pio and a bandage swatch which covered his side wound, for public veneration throughout the day.

### ABOUT PADRE PIO

Padre Pio, the humble yet widely recognized Italian Capuchin Friar, is a saint whose relics are prayerfully venerated by millions throughout the world, due to the amazing graces attributed to his powerful intercession. He is the first priest to have borne the Stigmata, the five bleeding wounds of Christ on the Cross, often wearing gloves in public to cover the bleeding wounds on his hands.

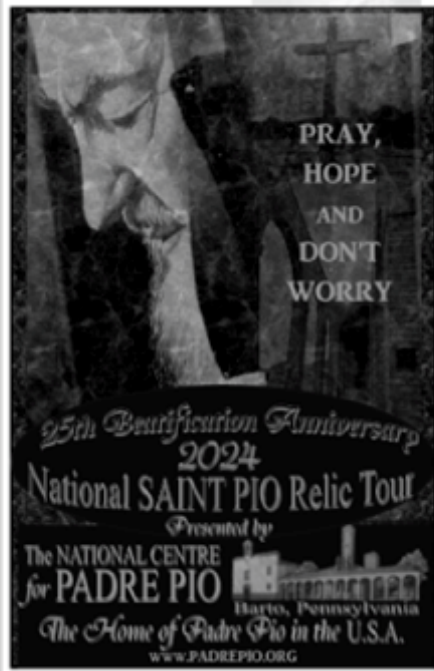
### ABOUT THE TOUR

The **#SaintPioRelicTour2024** features one of the gloves worn by Padre Pio. It is part of a year-long series of events being held in 2024 by the National Centre for Padre Pio in celebration of the 25th anniversary of his Beatification.

Founded in 1971 by Mrs. Vera M. Calandra, the National Centre for Padre Pio, known as the "Home of Padre Pio in the USA," is located in Barto, Pennsylvania. Their current facility, the Our Lady of Grace Chapel and Padre Pio Spirituality Centre, opened on May 2, 1999, the very day of Padre Pio's Beatification.

Veneration will be held throughout the day on Saturday, February 24, for conference attendees in the Mezzanine of Kasich Hall.

## JESUS CALLS US TO GO DEEPER

In a world full of hurt, deeply in need of healing, we are called to reunite with our true strength. **Jesus Christ invites us to return to the source and summit of our faith in the celebration of the Eucharist.**

### The Role of the Eucharist in the Church

— from the EWTN Library/eucharist makes the church

**The Eucharist is at the very core of the life of the Church and gives the Church its identity.**

The Church is the Body of Christ, and, as St. Augustine taught, we receive the body of Christ in order to become the body of Christ: "Be what you see and receive what you are."

**The whole mystery of Christ and of the Church as his body is what we receive in the Eucharist.** This sacrament therefore renews our life together in Christ; in other words, *it renews the Church.*

The life that we share in Christ is the life of the Trinity, because Christ is the Son of God incarnate, and that life is one of **perfect communion**. The phrase we use about receiving the Eucharist is really very significant; **we say we are receiving Communion.**

**We are receiving Christ himself, but the life he shares with us is the communion life of the Trinity** — the very life that calls us out of our own individualism and draws us together as the Church.

**The Eucharist renews the very gift that makes us to be the Church,** and it follows that **the community dimension of the Eucharist is of the utmost importance.** It is really communities, and ultimately the Church as a whole, that receives the Eucharist, not just lots of individuals.

We should always be conscious of those with whom we receive; **the Eucharist renews our life as brothers,** caring for one another and working together to bear witness to the communion life of the Kingdom of God.



When the priest prays the words of consecration at mass, **the bread and wine become Jesus's body, blood, soul, and divinity.**

**What was once bread and wine is now the Holy Eucharist.**

## 2024 CONFERENCE THE EUCHARIST: GO DEEPER

The history of the Church and Church Fathers shows the belief in the Real Presence since its first days...

### The Early Church Believed in the Real Presence

The doctrine of the Real Presence asserts that in the Holy Eucharist Jesus is literally and wholly present—body and blood, soul and divinity—under the appearances of bread and wine.

The Bible is forthright in declaring it (John 6: 32-71 | 1Cor 10: 16-17, 11: 23-29) and early Church Fathers interpreted the Bible literally. From the Church's early days, the Fathers referred to Christ's presence in the Eucharist.

“ I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is the flesh for the life of the world.”

— John 6: 51

**Two of the greatest historical minds show evidence of their unwavering belief in the Real Presence of the Holy Eucharist...**

### Ignatius of Antioch

Ignatius boldly declared that “the bread is the flesh of Jesus, the cup his blood,” clearly intending the realism to be taken seriously.

“ I have no taste for corruptible food nor for the pleasures of this life. I desire the bread of God, which is the flesh of Jesus Christ . . . and for drink I desire his blood, which is love incorruptible.”

— Letter to the Romans 7:3 (A.D. 110)

In his letter to the Smyrnaeans, Ignatius warned against heretical teaching and belief: “They abstain from the Eucharist... because they confess not the Eucharist to be the flesh of the Savior, Jesus Christ.

### Irenaeus of Lyon

Irenaeus was born around the year 130 in the city of Smyrna (now Izmir Turkey) and was a student of Polycarp. Polycarp was a student of John the Apostle and ordained by the Apostle. So, in Irenaeus, we are only 2 generations from people who knew Jesus.

“ He has declared the cup... to be his own blood, from which he causes our blood to flow; and the bread...he has established as his own body, from which he gives unto our bodies.”

— Against Heresies 5:2 (A.D. 189)
